**Morning Class: 9 AM—12 Noon**  
**Types and Shadows in the Bible:**  
**Hints of a Savior to the Americas**  
**Instructor: Rev. Alvin Deer**

Rev. Alvin Deer, a Kiowa Creek, is the past Executive Director of the Native American International Caucus of the United Methodist Church. He now fills the pulpit at Hitchitee United Methodist Church in Seminole, OK. He currently serves on the Board of Trustees for Cook Native American Ministries.

### Course Description

The Bible is a treasure of truths about the Heart of God, and his purpose for the whole world. Most is told in distinctive and direct language. But we also find Jesus talking, for example, in parables to bring forth biblical teachings about the Kingdom. What is overlooked many times are biblical truths called "Types and Shadows." This class will study the scriptures that deal with types and shadows in an effort to broaden ones understanding of the scriptures, and to even show that God's original plan for salvation included Native American nations as we study some very unique statements in the scriptures.

**Let Us Worship God!**  
**Instructor: Dr. Henry E. Fawcett**

Dr. Henry E. Fawcett is a member of the Tsimshian Tribe from Alaska. He is a retired Professor of Ministry, Emeritus and is currently serving as Interim Director of the Native American Program at the University of Dubuque Theology Seminary. Dr. Fawcett has been pastor of churches in Alaska, Nebraska, Minnesota, and Washington states. He is former Chair person of The Charles Cook Theological School Board of Trustees, and has served on numerous national committees of the Presbyterian Church (USA).

### Course Description

This course introduces students to topics of worship etiquette, with special concerns for the theological, pastoral, and contextual reason for our worship practices within the Native community.
